**Job Overview:** The selling supervisor leads a team of Sales Associates to engage with customers and visitors, selling merchandise and informing customers about product features and Hatch Show Print history and lore. Selling supervisors are the in-store customer service manager and leader.

- Complete daily closing routine with accuracy
- Complete work schedule for store to maximize staffing during high traffic periods
